**Septic System and Water Testing Results:** The septic system is now 100% operational and we have finally got to the bottom of the problem and identified a power supply issue, all sorted and business as usual.

Water update: tanks have been cleaned and pipes have been flushed. New filters were installed today (different to the UV filter) and following that, AQUALAB will run some more water quality tests for a couple of days.

The results of these tests should give us an all clear for risk free drinking, even the risk was very minimal to begin with. Please send your children to school with their own drinking water until we advise otherwise. I will update everyone very soon.
